4. **Matters Arising: a. Dunmail:** – no further information to date.
 - b. **Cedar Lodge:** - no contact as yet.
5. **Arnside Regeneration:-** Mr. and Mrs Sealey came because of a variety of rumours (all wrong) circulating about. Alan Piper explained what had been proposed and stressed that at this stage it was just proposals and that a leaflet drop had taken place throughout the area prior to six one hour public consultations held at various venues across Southmead. A copy of the leaflet and its conclusions were given to the Sealeys, in the hope that they would allay their fears.
6. **Monsdale/Richeson pre application response:** BCC response “The principle of housing is acceptable as is the layout. Ecology will need to be checked. It is recommended that the car spaces on the green be grouped together to mitigate the visual impact. Cycle parking to comply with adopted standards. Stores of refuse and recycling bins will be required to serve the houses. A SUDS concept drainage scheme will be required and energy strategy to comply with adopted standards.
7. **Filton Airfield:** An E. Mail had been received advising of a meeting on the site sometime during April/May.
8. **Pocket Park:** Since the meeting replied received from UWE to the effect that the insurance issue Has been settled and fabrication can now proceed.
